



Ellen Mary Ann Dunn

1879–1934

Ellen Mary Anne Dunn was born on February 25th, 1879, to Ellen Mary Dunnell (1857-1919) and John Dunn (1857-1925) at 56 Peerless Street, Islington, St. Luke's, London, England. The house is no longer there, it is now home to Moorfield's Eye Hospital. Ellen was a member of the 1895 British Ladies Football Club, when, at just sixteen years of age, she took part in the inaugural football match.

The match took place at Nightingale Lane, Crouch End, Hornsey, London, before a crowd of some 10,000 spectators. The ladies split into two teams, namely, North and South London. Ellen's team, North London, won by seven goals to one. The Ladies toured England, Scotland and Wales over the next two years. They played at what was possibly the first international ladies' football match, which took place on May 16th, 1896, at Jones' Road, (now Croke Park) in Dublin, Ireland.

Ellen married George Ambrose White (aka George Flexmore, professional comedian, 1877-1933) on February 27th, 1899 in Bethnal Green Registry Office. They had a daughter in July of that year, but the infant, a baby girl, arrived early and did not survive.

Ellen went on to enjoy a professional stage career spanning almost 30 years, performing her unique dance, contortion, singing and comedy repertoire as Lily Flexmore across the UK, Ireland, Europe, and the USA. George, who was a Representative for Associated Newspapers, was also an accomplished comedian, performing using the stage name George Flexmore. He passed away suddenly, at 55, on September 26th, 1933. Ellen, aged 54 years, died the following year, on January 19th, barely four months following the death of her husband. She passed away at St. Mary's Hospital, 77a Highgate Hill, Islington (now Whittington Hospital). Ellen and George are Reunited in Islington Cemetery.

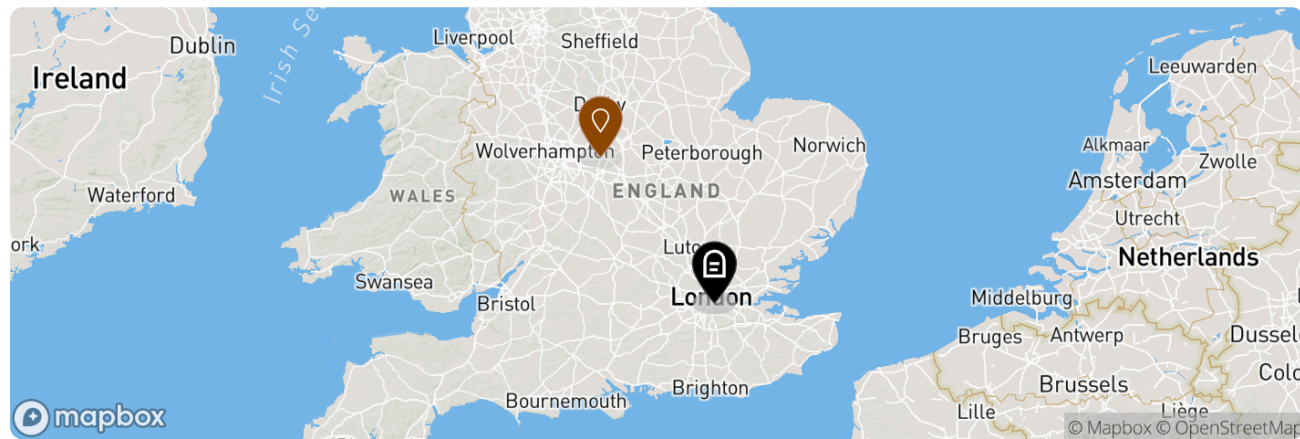

The Lady Footballers' Visit.
By "FRED."

We are a peculiar people, or rather, I should say, more curious than peculiar. When the announcement was made that the original lady footballers were to visit Belfast it raised a host of questions that never were explained on the occasion of an international match, so much so as to draw 15,000 strong of a crowd to Cliftonville ground last Wednesday evening. The dear "men" things, who have been depicting their "manly" forms to the gaze of the original Englishmen and the latter criticism that during the past few months, but they must see us, and accordingly they arrived by the "Admiral" on Wednesday, and put up at the Hotel Marlborough, College Square North, where Mr. Hinks attended to them. At first sight the ladies did not strike me as being able to handle our winter garb, and were, to say the least of it, in point of stature, a most nervous lot. The goalkeepers and backs (for here let me say the ladies played the best side of the two—amateurs) being perhaps an exception. It was a quarter of a hour late, or 7:45 before the game was started, the lady attacking the position goal, for to a man of this sort it does not matter much who wins the game. (I was of "go on Linfield and Cliftonville," for it was Miss v. Miss, was heard all over the field. The Misses had the best forward, but what deflected the lady attacking department had was surely aimed for by the original display of outside-left work done by "Little Daisy," whom a few of the crowd were a bit dubious of as regards sex, owing to their lively movements. In this as or not, the lot so made the Misses' position kick and pass eye, and she was the girl to do it, her drop-kicks being quite accurate, and making Tom Hunt, our international custodian blink in amazement. As the result of a nice encounter of the afternoon "11," the ladies, besides some other things, shot a goal. There is no use in wearying one with details, so that was all the scoring, the lady winning by a goal to nil. We must say readily the teams played much better than we anticipated, and all round did equally. All courses the display only served to make the more enthusiastic crowd which had been Linfield v. Cliftonville, but they were "into a man." I do not know what the game resulted, but suffice the ladies are Cliftonville would lose by the vote. There was a beautiful "kick" at the converted gate, and about a mile thousand got in free. This is more detail when the crowd gets up to a number of 10,000, with perhaps 1000 more waiting in. Our wish to see "ye fairies come" have been gratified, but as a show of football it was a failure, which can only be repeated. It is understood that the ladies will play a mutual one of the North End Juniors at Cliftonville ground in season.

British Ladies' Football Club.
In great view the women on Wednesday night at Cliftonville that as the result of a challenge issued, the committee of the British Ladies Football Club have decided to play an eleven specially selected from the two teams against one of the North End Juniors, which, considering this is the first time that the ladies have contested against a male team, we are highly honored. This is not the only attraction, as there will be "five-a-side" competitions for the ladies and one for the boys, for which a medal will be given for the greatest length the ball may be kicked. There will also be obstacle and 50 yards for both sexes, so that a big evening's sport is anticipated. The start will be at four o'clock, the match being the first time. The admission price for our annual football was 1d. and 3d.—so that there should be a large gate.

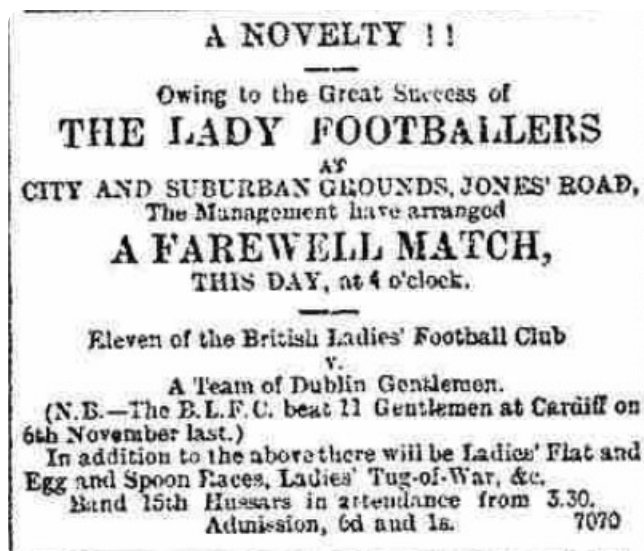
